Enjoy a full-day tour of one of the most important natural and cultural attractions in all of Ecuador.

The Enjoy Ecuador Tour Operator takes you to visit the city of Otavalo and a volcanic crater lake called Cuicocha, located in the Province of Imbabura, 1 hour 30 minutes from Quito.

We will make a stop in the city of Cayambe where we will have a traditional breakfast from the area that consists of biscuits, cheese and dulce de leche.

We will continue our tour and visit a viewpoint from which we can observe the San Pablo lagoon and the Imbabura volcano.



DAY 2 - FULL DAY OTAVALO

Once in Otavalo we will visit the famous poncho plaza, where you can experience the daily life of Otavalo merchants up close, you will have time to shop for the wide variety of crafts that this place has to offer such as: traditional ponchos, scarves , wooden sculptures, paintings, traditional pants, alpargatas, etc.

We will visit an artisan workshop of Andean musical instruments, where we will learn the different musical instruments that are used in various countries in the Andes.

We will have the opportunity to visit the Cuicocha Lagoon, where we will take a short walk and you will be able to take pictures of this amazing attraction.

We will visit the city of Cotacachi where we will have time for lunch and return to Quito.

DAY 3 - COTOPAXI Y QUILOTOA

ITINERARY DESCRIPTION

Enjoy a full-day tour of one of the most important natural attractions in all of Ecuador.

Enjoy Ecuador takes you to visit Cotopaxi, an active volcano, located in the Province of Cotopaxi, 1 hour 30 minutes from Quito.

Here we can get up close and personal with the endemic flora and fauna of the Cotopaxi National Park. If we have a sunny and clear day we will have the opportunity to observe this imposing volcano.

Later we will visit the interpretation center to learn about the avenue of volcanoes and the importance of the care and protection of the moor.

We will take a walk through one of the largest natural lagoons within the Cotopaxi National Park, called Limpiopungo, where we can observe several birds and medicinal plants.



DAY 3 - COTOPAXI Y QUILOTOA

ITINERARY DESCRIPTION

We will continue our adventure by visiting the Quilotoa lagoon, a volcanic crater lake, located in the Province of Cotopaxi, 2 hours 20 minutes from the Cotopaxi National Park.

We will make a stop at an artisanal painting workshop in Tigua, a small town that has great artists who make paintings on sheepskin with acrylic paint, in which they teach us about their daily lives. On this tour we will be able to visit one of the most beautiful places in the Los Ilinizas Ecological Reserve. If we have a sunny and clear day we will have the opportunity to observe the Quilotoa lagoon and its characteristic turquoise blue color.

We will visit the different community viewpoints that are located in Quilotoa. They also have several craft stores for you to visit.

To end the day we will move to our accommodation in Baños de Agua Santa.

DAY 4 - BAÑOS DE AGUA SANTA

ITINERARY DESCRIPTION

The tour operator Enjoy Ecuador invites you to enjoy a tour in the city of Baños de Agua Santa.

We will begin the tour after a delicious breakfast at the hotel.

Baños is a city frequently visited by people from all over the world to be able to do adventure sports and closely observe one of the highest active volcanoes in Ecuador, such as the Tungurahua volcano.

We will begin our tour by visiting the “El pailón del diablo” waterfall, where we will take a 15-minute walk to reach a viewpoint located at the base of the waterfall, which is around 80 m high, its a unique experience.

We will continue with our journey towards the waterfall “El manto de la novia”, the same one that we will visit using a tarabita (cable car).

We will also have time if you want to do adventure sports at the Adventure Park Rio Blanco, where they offer canopy activities, Tibetan bridge, bungee jumping, glass bridge, etc.

We will have free time for lunch and we will visit the viewpoint "La Casa del Arbol", if the day is sunny and clear you will have the opportunity to take incredible photos in this place.

To finish the tour we will make a last stop at the viewpoint "Las Manos de la Pachamama", you will have the opportunity to see one of the most important attractions of Baños de Agua Santa, with a privileged view of the city.

Finally, we will transfer to the hotel where you can enjoy its facilities and have free time to relax or if you wish, you can enjoy the nightlife that Baños offers.

This complex is visually designed like an old colonial city. This complex has several attractions such as: the ancestral homes of the equator, history of the French geodesic mission, history of the equator, experiments on gravity and data on the equator line, Ecuadorian cocoa museum, history of the Quitus, craft brewery, history train, craft shops, restaurants, history of colonial churches, etc.

You will have time to visit the attractions of your choice, you will be able to take photographs and even stamp your passport in which your visit to the middle of the world will be marked.

We will taste some traditional Paila ice creams and transfer to the Quito International Airport for your return flight home.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

PAYMENTS are accepted in cash or by wire transfer through the **PAYPAL** app. **The link for payment will only be sent by Enjoy Ecuador S.A.S.**

MULTI-DAY TOURS: To confirm the services, a payment of 70% of the total value of the tour must be made 30 days before the beginning of the tour. The remaining 30% can be paid in cash upon arrival in Quito - Ecuador or by transfer to **PAYPAL**.

- It should be taken into account that each transfer made through **PAYPAL** must increase by 15%, which is the cost for the transaction charged by the application.

TERMS OF CANCELLATION



- Up to 30 days before the beginning of the tour: penalty equivalent to 15% of the total invoice amount.
- Up to 15 days before the beginning of the tour: penalty equivalent to 40% of the total invoice amount.
- Up to 10 days or less before the beginning of the tour: penalty equivalent to 100% of the total invoice amount.

A credit note equivalent to the amount already paid, penalty subtracted, will be issued.



GENERAL TERMS

At the time of receiving this document, it is the obligation of each passenger to read it. All ENJOY ECUADOR S.A.S passengers accept the following terms.
